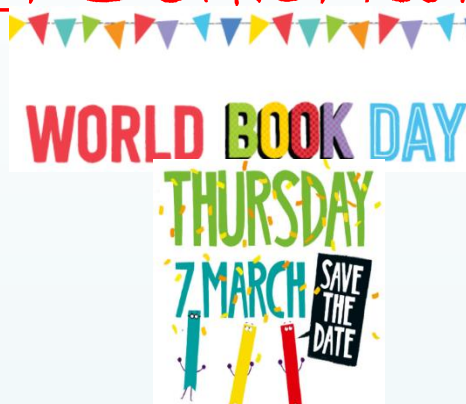
Make a hat or the theme for this challenge is Springtime. Shock us with your ideas. Prizes for all entries.
