Dear Parent/Carer,

For a number of years there have been problems outside school regarding inconsiderate, dangerous and illegal parking during the dropping off and picking up of youngsters at this school Farringdon Street, Birchills Street & Thomas Street in particular is a problem as it is a busy route with a high volume of traffic.

Driveways in the area must never be blocked in anyway, pavements must not be parked on, even partially and road junction corners must not be obstructed.

As a school, we have been in consultation with West Midlands Police regarding this matter. It has been decided that in partnership with the Police, we will introduce the 'Junior PCSO scheme'.

The Police will train specially selected pupils to be Junior PCSOs. These Junior PCSOs will wear a high visibility tabard and black cap clearly showing the Junior PCSO logo. One of their duties will be to patrol with Police officers outside school at regular intervals, speaking in a non-confrontational manner with drivers about their inconsiderate, illegal or dangerous parking. If necessary, the Junior PCSOs will issue specially designed 'tickets' to drivers. If a driver receives two of these tickets and the issue of a third becomes necessary, then West Midlands Police will issue the appropriate Fixed Penalty Notice ticket.

I hope that you can support this exciting scheme which will help to make the school and the area around it a safer place.
